Ms. Weesner reviewed the sign that has disappeared on Silver and Memorial that the contractor must replace. She added that there were six (6) additional intersections without signage and the Authority may consider additional signage. Weesner stated that the Projects Committee has reviewed the additional locations and recommended approving the signs.

Upon a motion brought by Director Hall, seconded by Director Neisel, the Board unanimously approved the replacement of signage at Silver and Memorial to be paid for by the contractor; and (ii) the additional six (6) locations not to exceed \$10,000.

# Monthly Financial Report Summary February Board Meeting Wednesday February 21, 2024

At the beginning of December, the Old Sixth Ward Redevelopment Authority (OSWRA) beginning Operating Fund Balance was \$5,083,749. During the months, OSWRA received \$43,495 mainly from money market interest. OSWRA processed \$178,111 in disbursements during the period. 82% of the disbursement related to payments to Traffic Systems Construction, Inc for Capital Improvement Projects (\$107,783), Edminster Hinshaw Russ (\$25,510), and Goodman Corp (\$11,875) for Consulting. The ending balance as of month end January 31, 2024 was \$4,949,133.

The invoices pending approval total \$289,445.90 See attached "Unpaid Bills Detail" Report on page 3.

Capital Improvement Project spending for the period totaled \$11,863. The funds were spent towards the Silver Street Improvements. See page 4 for the "Capital Projects Detail" Reports.

During December, the opening balance for the Texas Class investment account was \$4,826,681. We received \$21,501 in interest (5.2346%) in December. During January, the opening balance for the Texas Class investment account was \$4,848,182. We received \$21,710 in interest (5.2760%) in January. The ending balance for January is \$4,869,892.
